In 1983 Autodesk introduced AutoCAD for the PC. CAD users soon discovered that it was easier to use than a mouse-driven CAD system. AutoCAD software was initially released in two parts, AutoCAD for Windows (AutoCADW) and AutoCAD for OS/2. AutoCAD came on floppy disks and tape cassettes, in 4.5-inch and 5.25-inch floppy diskettes. For the first two years, users could acquire and run AutoCAD only on a computer running an OS/2 operating system. In 1985, Autodesk released AutoCAD for MS-DOS and later for Windows 3.x and Windows 95. In 1994 Autodesk released AutoCAD NT, which runs on Windows NT, Windows 95, Windows 98, Windows 2000, and Windows XP. In October 2000, Autodesk introduced AutoCAD 2000, which runs on Windows NT, Windows 2000, Windows XP, and Windows Vista. In October 2006, Autodesk launched AutoCAD 2009 for Windows. In the late 1980s, the use of AutoCAD exploded, as it was adopted by engineers, architects, mechanical designers, and other professionals in virtually every industry. By 1991 Autodesk had more than 50,000 regular users. By 1994 Autodesk had more than 150,000 users. In 1997 Autodesk had more than 350,000 users. In 1999 Autodesk had more than 500,000 users. In 2001, Autodesk acquired the fledgling competitor Corel (a CAD drafting company), which was acquired by the Israeli software company, Corel in 2002. In 2003, Autodesk introduced AutoCAD LT for the Mac. In 2005 Autodesk introduced AutoCAD Architecture, a version specifically designed for architects. By 2011 Autodesk had more than 2 million users. AutoCAD History AutoCAD's roots in the field of computer-aided drafting and design (CAD) go back to the late 1970s and early 1980s. The origins of AutoCAD go back to Stanford University's Sketchpad. Sketchpad was developed in the late 1970s and early 1980s by Frank O. Covell (Stanford University) and Bob Taylor (California Polytechnic State University). This first program was simple and accessible, but with limited functionality. It was first

About LISP LISP (a subset of the ALGOL language) was the first language to be designed for programming interactive systems and remained popular for a long time.

LISP syntax is convenient for the use of short programs that manipulate simple structures and do not need to scale to larger data structures. History LISP was introduced in 1966 by John McCarthy. McCarthy had earlier been a student of the first Turing Award winner, Alonzo Church. Although the LISP programming language did not use the lambda-calculus (Church lambda calculus), it was one of the first languages to make this substitution, and the first to support this. The lambda-calculus is also

known as the applicative order and is used to define operations in functional programming languages. Lisp syntax uses the following symbols: single quotes: any character double quotes: a string (see quotes in Lisp) parentheses: control structure

Syntax In addition to the symbols listed above, the LISP programming language supports the use of the following statements: (1) A comma separated list of arguments (called arguments) (2) For loops with a specified condition. The loop begins executing the command it contains and continues as long as the condition is true. (3) The do loop.

The loop executes a list of commands until the condition becomes false. (4) A statement. Statements consist of a list of words that, when executed, produce the result of the expression. (5) The print statement, where is a form of the print function.

Functions LISP is often described as a functional programming language because it does not have loops, conditionals or variables. Functions have their own expressions, which are combined using the + operator. Examples In the following example, the two words "Hello" and "World" are assigned to the words x and y. The words concatenate the arguments (meaning they were each previously separated by a comma) and they are placed between the parentheses. In the end the value of the variable z, is calculated by adding the values of x and y. (defun add (x y) (+ x y)) In the following examples, the arguments x, y and z are passed into the function add. The output will be 1. (add 2
